One More Day is open to all students who are attending WSYC during the 2024-2025 school year. Age groups may be determined based upon the number of children in attendance. The majority of the day will be outside supervised by a team of WSYC Advisory Board Members and substitutes. Please bring a labeled water bottle and extra change of clothes (jelly slippers and wipes if needed). Drop-off will be in the classrooms and pick-up will be held outside on the playground (in case of inclement weather). Snacks will be provided by WSYC.
